Consortia Courses

- Attendance
 - Let school office know if you have been absent from your course. You will be asked.
- Punctuality
 - Bus leaves at 1.10 – you CANNOT miss it! Report to office if you do.
- Bus passes
 - If you are entitled, these can be picked up from office by 1.10pm. Permanent bus passes will be sent home if entitled.
- Other schools
 - Check taxi times with school office if unsure.
 - Let school office know in advance if you don't need the taxi!



HWB

- **HFT/Hospitality payments**
 - Payment due by end of September via school system online payment system
 - Balance must be paid before purchasing any further school events

- **PE**
 - Kit should be worn at all times even when a pupil provides a medical note.
 - Long term medical should be in the form of a doctors line, especially if a pupil is unable to participate in swimming.
 - Pupils arriving with no kit will be asked to wear the department PE kit.
