1. Use of ICT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ICT it useful because pupils don't have to carry around printouts from different classes. • ICT also allows the communication between pupils and teachers outside of school, if the pupils are stuck then they can ask for help. • Some netbooks are damaged and therefore require fixing. • The role of Digital Leaders should be more important and they should be able to educate pupils on how to use glow and its services. • Teams is also a useful application.
