Agenda Item:	Discussion:
1. School Scarf	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meeting was attended by Douglas from Border Embroideries who provided pupils with examples of scarves that they design and rough prices. These were shown to pupils who then had the opportunities to ask him questions and discuss which ones they prefer. The cheapest designs are £9.10+VAT and the more expensive designs are £11.50+VAT. The minimum order would be 50, with 6-8 weeks delivery time. The school could request a 'bespoke' design by deciding on which colours schemes and the possibility of adding the badge. The school would have to give an exact order number before production. A pupil suggested each house having its own scarf, however this would require a minimum order of 50 from each house. • It was decided that members of the Junior Pupil Council will meet with Mr Smith next week to create a questionnaire to put to pupils to let them decide on their preferred design.
2. School's vision, values and aims	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mr Phee explained to pupils that there is a review taking place of the school's vision, values and aims. Teachers have already been consulted on this and parents will soon be consulted too. SLT would like the input of pupils. The pupil council were given a copy of the current vision, values and aims and were given the opportunity to discuss these. • There was a discussion on the best way to consult pupils on this matter – whether to consult <i>all</i> pupils via Health & Wellbeing or RE classes or just those pupils who wish to take part. It was decided to take the latter approach. Members of the Junior Pupil Council will now meet with Mr Smith next week then during form class will canvass names of pupils who would like to take part in this consultation process.
