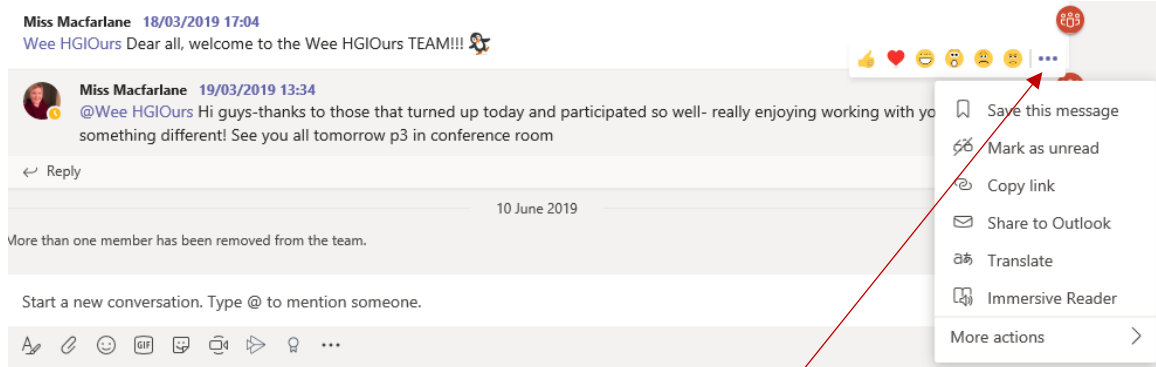


Microsoft TEAMS/WORD and Dyslexia: Immersive Reader

Reading posts on Microsoft TEAMS: Immersive Reader

Immersive Reader increases the readability of content by allowing students to hear posts read aloud, change font size, line spacing and change background colour to suit their preference. To access “Immersive Reader” in TEAMS:



Hover over a post and click the 3 dots in the top right hand corner. A menu will appear - click ‘Immersive Reader’. There are a number of icons that allow you to adjust to suit preferences (shown below).



What these icons mean?



VOICE: This allows the text to be read aloud to pupils. You can change the voice speed of reading and voice selection (male or female) to suit your preference.



TEXT: You can change your text preference to make text larger or smaller. You can increase spacing, change font size and background colour to suit your preference.



GRAMMAR: This area allows you to have words broken down into syllables. It also allows students to identify different parts of speech e.g. Noun, Verb and Adjective.



READING PREFERENCE: allows you to adjust lines, pictures and translation (by word or whole document)
