- Your child's name
- Your child's House & Year Group
- Reason for absence (if applicable)
- Probable length of absence (if known)

Unplanned absence

If an absence is **unplanned**, on their return to school, pupils should bring a note confirming the period of absence and reason/s.

Late for school?

There is a warning bell at 8.57am and school begins at **9:00am**.

Pupils who arrive after 9:00am will be marked **Late for Class**

If pupils are late, they should in at the **Reception area**
