Please note that some students may be invited by their pastoral teacher to choose a new subject for S4 such as Care, SCOTS (FV College), Personal Development, Outdoor Education or other targeted college courses if these subjects suit their chosen pathway. Contact will be made with relevant parents/carers in due course if applicable. Students can indicate on the form if they are interested in being considered for some of those subjects.
