

WHAT QUALIFICATIONS DO WE OFFER?



About 70% of our students go onto study at college or university, which traditionally require passes at National 4, National 5 or Higher level. We, therefore need to provide qualifications for the remaining 30% of students, who might not have traditional SQA qualifications.

Other qualifications we offer alongside Nationals, Highers and Advanced Highers which are fully recognised on the Scottish Qualification Framework. are summarised below:

SOME OTHER QUALIFICATIONS ON OFFER



FOUNDATION APPRENTICESHIP (FA)

A Foundation Apprenticeship (FA) is **industry recognised**. Students learn **skills** that **employers want** through a **planned work placement** with a **local employer** and **vocational** studies at college.

FAs are recognised at **SCQF Level 5** (Nat 5) or **Level 6**(Higher Level) and can be a **stepping stone** to a Modern or Graduate Apprenticeship.

Level of study available:

SCQF LEVEL: 5 or 6*



NATIONAL PROGRESSION AWARD

National Progression Awards (NPA) develop a range of additional **vocational** or **work related** skills, often through **direct** experience with employers.

National Progression Awards are highly **valued by employers**, but can also provide **progression** to apprenticeships or college studies.

SCQF LEVEL: 4, 5 & 6*



NATIONAL CERTIFICATE (NC)

A National Certificate (NC) Is sometimes suitable for students with **no formal qualifications.** They offer practical help in developing **skills for work.**

NCs focus on **vocational**learning.
Learners can progress to study HNC if they pass the
NC award.

Level of study available:

SCQF LEVEL: 3, 4, 5 & 6*



HIGHER NATIONAL CERTIFICATE (HNC)

A Higher National Certificate (HNC) takes **one** or **two years** to complete if you are still at school.

HNCs are vocational qualifications which focus on 'learning by doing' and learning skills required for a particular job. Successful completion can lead to further study at college or

university. **Level of study available:**

SCQF LEVEL: 7*



SKILLS for WORK

Skills for Work (SfW) courses focus on **employability skills** needed to **prepare learners** for a specific job.

Students get opportunities to learn skills through practical experiences in many vocational areas including beauty, engineering, sport, maritime, childcare and energy.

Level of study available:

SCOF LEVEL: 4, 5 & 6*



CITY & GUILDS (C & Gs)

City and Guilds are vocational and technical qualifications which are industry based. They can be studied in the class, the workplace or both.

City & Guild qualifications are a **stepping stone** to a **job** or to **further study** in areas including hair & beauty and make up artistry

SCOF LEVEL: 4,5 & 6*



BACCALAUREATE (I.D.L. - Languages)

The IDL aims to develop skills through a languages based project designed to draw on many areas of learning from across the curriculum.

The IDL should make connections between languages and the world in which students live, learn and work.

SCQF LEVEL: 7*
